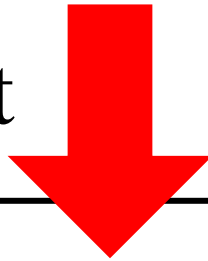


STEP 1: Copy the following words into the **REASON** column of your chart . . .

MOVEMENT

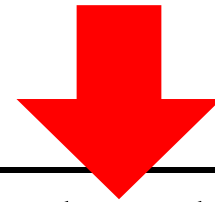
- Decide which of the key words on your paper are **push factors** and which are **pull factors**
