Persian Gulf War






PEOPLE Saddam Hussein Iraqi President

DATES 1990-1991 CAUSE Iraq invades Kuwait over oil





PEOPLE President George H. Bush



OUTCOME

- Iraq must withdrawal from Kuwait
- Saddam Hussein stays in power, but must destroy all WMDs (weapons of mass destruction), such as nuclear or biological
 - weapons



September 11 Attacks

- 2001
- Osama bin-Laden
- Al Qaeda (terrorist group)
- Twin Towers of World Trade Center (New York City)
- Pentagon (Wash. D.C.)





EVENTS





CAUSE Bin-Laden wanted to remove U.S./western influence and power in the Middle East



OUTCOME

- Over 3,000 ppl died
- Increased security
- U.S. invades Afghanistan to find Osama bin-Laden





Invasion of Afghanistan

- U.S. invades
 Afghanistan in 2001
- Taliban (group controlling the Afghan government)
- protecting Osama bin-Laden and al-Qaeda



so the U.S. invades Afghanistan to find bin-Laden Taliban announces to the world that they will not give up Osama bin-Laden . . .



• U.S. still fighting to keep Taliban from returning

• Killed Osama bin Laden in 2011

- fearing Saddam Hussein had WMDs (weapons of mass destruction)
















- No WMDs were ever found
- U.S. still fighting in Iraq, though withdrawn troops below 50,000
- Saddam Hussein put on trial in Iraqi court and hanged for crimes against his people
- Iraq is democracy where people vote for leaders, though differing factions (*ex. Sunni, Shia, Kurdish*) still bitterly disagree who should control country and how
