## **Essential Question**

What is the impact of diverse languages and diverse religions on the culture in Europe?

#### Europe is a continent of diverse languages.



Some are in the same language FAMILY, so people from one country can often understand the language of people from another country.

# Many Europeans are BILINGUAL (speak 2 languages)

or MULTILINGUAL (speak several languages).

# These languages families include:

GERMANIC ROMANCE SLAVIC

#### **GERMANIC:**

**Uses our alphabet.** 

Examples include German and English.

**English** is spoken in more parts of the world than any other language.

#### **ROMANCE**

**Uses our alphabet.** 

**Examples include French and Italian.** 

The Romance languages are based on Latin, the language of the ancient Romans.

#### **SLAVIC**

Uses a Cyrillic alphabet based on ancient Greek letters.

Russian is an example of Slavic language.

#### **Europe's Many Languages**

There are at least 60 different languages in Europe!

Imagine Europe's size—it's about 4 million square miles, or about ½ the size of the United States (9,629,881 sq. miles). How do you think speaking over 60 languages in such a small area affects Europeans?

Imagine driving from Georgia to South Carolina, Florida, Alabama, or Tennessee, and having to speak a different language in each of those states.
