### **Brochure/Pamphlet**

- Must be a three-fold pamphlet.
- Include pictures and written
- Topic: Fall of Aztecs and Incas

## Newspaper Article

- Must include a picture with caption that supports the article.
- Topic: Any Latin America History topic (see above)
- Looks like a newspaper.

### **Folded Quiz Book**

- Paper folded in half with 10 flaps.
- Must include 10 questions.
- Questions about ALL Latin America American history topics.
- Answers must be True/False or Multiple Choice.

You must select 3 activities to complete in Tic-Tac-Toe order.

### Cartoon/Comic Strip

- Include at least 6 frames.
- Must have meaningful dialogue about Latin America.
- Must tell a story about Slavery or the Zapatista Movement

### Design a T-Shirt

- Create a t-shirt or bookmark about today's topic.
- Write 3 sentences explaining your t-shirt or bookmark.
- **COLOR REQUIRED**
- Any Latin American History topic (see above)

### **Commemorative Stamp**

Design a stamp that features something that we have studied in this unit. (It could be a location, event, person, etc.) Don't forget to add the postage rate and to color your stamp! In the textbox, explain why you chose this particular event/person for your stamp.

### **Drawing**

- Create a drawing illustrating one of the ancient Native American civilizations.
- Must have a title and brief description of what you drew.
- May be any Latin American History topic (see above)

### Compare/Contast (Aztecs and Incas)

Compare and contrast 2 or more ideas using a Venn Diagram, T-Chart, or a compare and contrast diagram of your own. Write a paragraph that summarizes the comparison.

### **Wanted Poster**

- Create a wanted poster for either Hernan Cortez or Francisco Pizarro.
- What did they look like?
- Reward amount listing the specific crime committed.
- A made up quote from a person who lived during the time period. Written description of what the person had done
